Friends are important and valuable. Proverbs 18:24 says, "Friends can destroy one another, but a loving friend can stick closer than family." Friends share one another's burdens and celebrate one another's successes and faithfulness. Friendship provides a space for us to share life, experiences, and love. Also, friendship provides an intimate relationship that emphasizes trust and accountability.

Betrayal by a friend is especially painful. Jesus felt the pain of a friend's unfaithfulness, Peter denied that he was Jesus' friend or that he even knew him. However, Jesus forgave Peter and even made him a leader in the church.

I'm thankful that the scriptures share the story of Peter's denial of Jesus and Jesus' restoration of Peter. It reminds me, in my worst moments, that Jesus recognizes my humanity and weaknesses. In spite of them, Jesus loves me deeply and is more than willing to forgive my sins and shortcomings. This story reminds me that failure is never final, and that Jesus has a place and a job for me within the kingdom even when I've made mistakes and will continue to make mistakes.

Ultimately, the story reminds me that I can not be so self-righteous as to think I cannot fail or have no need to ask for forgiveness. The only sinner Jesus won't forgive is the one that refuses to acknowledge his sin or is so prideful to ask for forgiveness.
