That is why we have been focusing on the "one another" commands of the New Testament (a printed list of these passages can be found on

the table in the foyer) on Sunday mornings. Our hope is that God will cultivate a spirit and a way of life that calls us to self-giving love, hospitality, encouragement, mutual submission, and mutual responsibility for one another. We must work to cultivate this kind of life through intentional effort and purposeful practices.

Our aim is to create and sustain a space where our primary focus is on the "we" rather than the "me." This is difficult to do in the consumeristic and individualistic culture in which we find ourselves. However, it is what God is calling us into.

I think one of the keys to faithfully living into this kind of life together is expressed well by David Fitch, "Today, we don't need a church that allows us to fit God into our lives. We need a church that shapes us to fit our lives into God's." When this is our aim, we'll focus more on the "we" than the "me."
